



## **Parents/Guardians:**

## Register to review your child's activity in Schoology Learning


- 1. In your browser, navigate to <a href="https://app.schoology.com/register">https://app.schoology.com/register</a>
  - a. If you have already registered for a Parent Account or have been given log-in credentials by your child's school, proceed to <a href="https://app.schoology.com/login">https://app.schoology.com/login</a>
- 2. Select the **Parent** button from the options.



3. You should have received a Parent Access Code from your child's school, in the format XXXX-XXXX. Enter that code here:




4. Enter your name, email address, and password (minimum of 12 characters).



(If your email address is already associated with another Schoology Parent Account at a different school or district, you'll need to contact them to have it released.)

- 5. Upon clicking 'Register,' you'll be logged in to your new Parent Account and see your Schoology Home Page. To learn more about navigating Schoology, <u>click here</u>.
- 6. To browse your child's activity, locate your name in the upper right corner, then click the drop-down arrow next to your name and select your child's name.



7. You also have the option to associate additional children using Schoology Learning with this account. To associate additional children, click the drop-down arrow next to your name in the upper right corner, then select +Add Child, and enter the Parent Access Code of your other child(ren).

**Note:** Though you will be viewing the Schoology Courses, Groups and Updates that your child sees, remember, that as a parent, you are simply viewing this information and are not able to act as your child in the courses. The banner at the top will remind you that you are viewing as your child.
