Do you currently utilize the Assessment Management Platform (AMP) at your district?

Our first release of District Mastery, which the Standards-Based Gradebook is part of, will not be compatible with AMP assessments. As such, we highly recommend that your district wait to rollout District Mastery until this capability is available. Please reach out to your Schoology representative should you have any questions.

Does your district currently use the existing Mastery functionality in Schoology? If you aren't sure, have you or anyone at your district built learning objectives in Schoology?

We do not currently have a way to transfer existing learning objectives or standards into the new District Mastery solution. The Schoology team is currently working on a migration plan to help assist districts who have been using the legacy Mastery functionality.

If your district has a centralized approach to standards, you can turn on the new District Mastery system while still referencing old mastery in archived courses.

If you don't have a centralized approach to standards, our recommendation would be to wait to rollout District Mastery. Alternatively, you could begin testing the functionality within a "dummy" building in your Schoology instance. See here for instructions on the testing process.
